1 How to use

We use the Past Continuous to talk about:

- an action that was happening at a specific time in the past.
- an action that was in progress when another action happened.
- two actions happening at the same time in the past.



2 Form

	Affirmative (+)	Negative (-)	Question (?)
I / He / She / It	was + V-ing	was not + V-ing (wasn't)	Was + subject + V-ing?
You / We / They	were + V-ing	were not + V-ing (weren't)	Were + subject + V-ing?

Examples



I was reading a book at 8 p.m.



He was playing football yesterday.



They were talking at that time.

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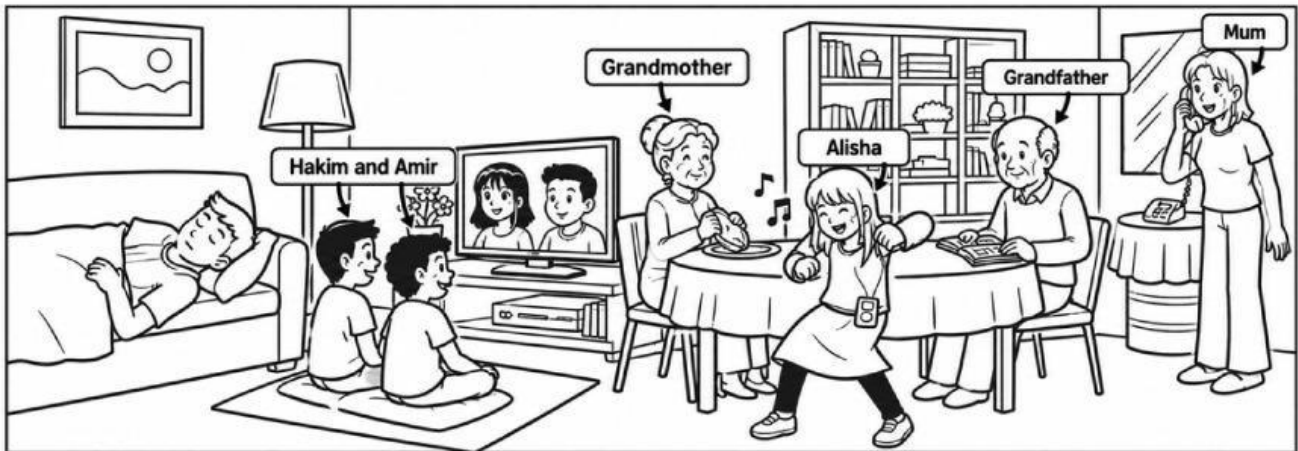
