

FIRST AND SECOND CONDITIONAL

1st CONDITIONAL

STRUCTURE



IF-CLAUSE -> SIMPLE PRESENT
go / goes / don't go / doesn't go

RESULT/MAIN CLAUSE -> FUTURE SIMPLE
will + infinitive

To talk about situations that will likely possibly or probably happen in the future.

Example

If I study harder, I will pass my exams easily. (It's very likely that this may happen)

2nd CONDITIONAL

STRUCTURE



IF-CLAUSE + SIMPLE PAST
went / didn't go

MAIN CLAUSE -> WOULD
would + base form

To talk about Imaginary, hypothetical, unreal or impossible situations in the present and very unlikely situations

Example

If I studied harder, I would pass my exams.
(But I don't do it - I'm just imagining this)

If I were an animal, I could fly like a bird.
(modals such as could /might and should are used in the 2nd cond.)
