The simple past tense describes actions that happened and ended in the past.



Subject + V2 (past form) + O.



Subject + did not + V1 (base form) + O.

I played soccer.	I didn't play soccer.
You watched TV.	You didn't watch TV.
He ate lunch.	He didn't eat lunch.
She read news.	She didn't read news.
It made noise.	It didn't make noise.
We drink tea.	We didn't drink tea.
They studied art.	They didn't study art.
