

# Simple present:

Change these words into simple present by adding (-s\ -es\ -ies)

Most words takes **-s**

If the word ends with (ss\ sh\ ch\ x\ o) it takes **-es**

If the word ends with a vowel (a\ u\ i\ o\ e) + y it takes **-s**

If the word ends with a consonant + y, we remove the y and add **-ies**.

# Simple past

Change the word between brackets into simple past by adding (-ed\ -d\ -ied):

- a. \_\_\_\_\_ (you\ finish) your homework?
- b. She \_\_\_\_\_ (try) to bake a cake yesterday.
- c. \_\_\_\_\_ (not\ you\ listen) to this song a few minutes ago?
- d. My brother and I \_\_\_\_\_ (play) tennis yesterday.
- e. The bus \_\_\_\_\_ (stop) at the traffic light.
- f. Lila \_\_\_\_\_ (visit) their grandparents last Monday.
- g. She \_\_\_\_\_ (dance) all night long.

Most words take **-ed**. (finish \_\_ finished).

If the words ends with an -e we add only a **-d** (lie \_\_ lied).

If the word ends with a vowel (a\ u\ i\ o\ e) + y it takes **-ed**.

If the word ends with a consonant + y, we remove the y and add **-ied**. (Cry \_\_ cried).

Some words we double the last letter and add **-ed**.

(Hug\_ hugged).
