Some rights	Meanings
1. Aboriginal peoples' rights	These rights protect people when they meet or have problems with the police or when they go to court.
2. equality rights	People of different abilities, ethnic groups, genders, religions, etc. have the same rights and opportunities.
3. freedom of religion	People can move and travel to a different part of Canada. They can enter and leave Canada freely.
4. freedom of speech	Indigenous people (people whose families who have lived in Canada for thousands of years) have special, traditional rights.
5. freedom of thought	People can have their own ideas and beliefs.
6. legal rights	People can communicate their ideas.
7. mobility rights	People can meet with others in big or small groups in a peaceful way.
8. the right to peaceful assembly	People can follow any religion in the way they want. They can also have no religion.
