

Regras ortográficas para verbos terminados em -ing	Exemplos
A maioria dos verbos: verbo + ing	do + ing → (talk + ing →
Verbos terminados em e : verbo - e + ing	use - e + ing → become - e + ing →
Verbos terminados em consoante + vogal + consoante : verbo + última consoante + ing	stop + p + ing → swim + m + ing -
Verbos terminados em ie: verbo - ie + y + ing	die - ie + ing →
