

PRESENT SIMPLE.

	AFFIRMATIVE	NEGATIVE	INTERROGATIVE
I	I play	I don't play	Do I play...?
YOU	You play	You don't play	Do you play...?
HE/SHE/IT	He/she/it plays*	He/she/it doesn't play	Does he/she/it play...?
WE	We play	We don't play	Do we play...?
YOU	You play	You don't play	Do you play...?
THEY	They play	They don't play	Do they play...?

* REMEMBER * HE/SHE/IT

In general, in the third person we add 'S' but we can find some exceptions:

For verbs that end in **-O**, **-CH**, **-SH**, **-SS**, **-X**, or **-Z** we add **-ES** in the third person.

- go – goes
- catch – catches
- wash – washes
- kiss – kisses
- fix – fixes
- buzz – buzzes

For verbs that end in a **consonant + Y**, we remove the **Y** and add **-IES**.

- marry – marries
- study – studies
- carry – carries
- worry – worries

NOTE: For verbs that end in a **vowel + Y**, we just add **-S**.

- play – plays
- enjoy – enjoys
- say – says



WE USE THE PRESENT SIMPLE:

- For repeated or regular actions
Example: John sleeps eight hours every night during the week.
- For facts
Example: The president of The USA lives in The White House.
- For habits
Example: Carol brushes her teeth twice a day.
- For things that are always/generally true.
Example: It rains a lot in winter.

AS YOU KNOW THERE ARE SOME VERBS IN PRESENT WHICH ARE EXCEPTIONS: VERB TO BE AND HAVE GOT.

WE USE THE PRESENT CONTINUOUS:

- For actions that are happening at the moment of speaking.
Example: I'm working at the moment.
Julie is sleeping.

VERBOS QUE NO SE UTILIZAN EN PRESENTE CONTINUO

Existen una serie de verbos que normalmente no pueden emplearse en Presente Continuo, excepto en ocasiones excepcionales:

- **Verbos que expresan sensaciones:** feel (sentir), hear (oír), see (ver) o smell (oler).
- **Verbos que expresan posesión:** belong (pertenecer), own (ser propietario de) o possess (poseer).
- **Verbos que expresan sentimientos o emociones:** desire (anhelar), detest (detestar), dislike (disgustar), fear (temer), hate (odiar), like (gustar), love (amar), respect (respetar), want (querer) o wish (desear).
- **Verbos que expresan actividades mentales:** agree (estar de acuerdo), believe (creer), forget (olvidar), know (saber), realize (darse cuenta), recognize (reconocer), remember (recordar), suppose (suponer), think (pensar) o understand (entender).
