3 Read this text about Mark Zuckerberg's biography until now and answer these questions.

Mark Elliot Zuckerberg was born on May 14, 1984 in Dobbs Ferry, New York. He grew up in a comfortable, well-educated family.

As a child, he lived with his three sisters, his father, Edward Zuckerberg, who was a dentist, and his mother, Karen, who worked as a psychiatrist.

Mark Zuckerberg developed an interest in computers at an early age; when he was 12, he used Atari BASIC to create a messaging program he named "Zucknet."

Mark graduated from Exeter in 2002 and he enrolled at Harvard University in 2003. He was accepted because he had good results at school. At Harvard, he began to work on his own social network. Mark and his friends created a site that allowed users to create their own profiles, upload photos, and communicate with other users. They named it "The Facebook". Some of his partners at Harvard didn't like Zuckerberg. They said that he stole their idea, and started a legal dispute.

Meanwhile, Zuckerberg and his team managed facebook from their bedroom at Harvard. In August 2004, Zuckerberg dropped out of college and moved the company to California.

Facebook became very popular. Yahoo! and MTV Networks wanted to buy facebook but Zuckerberg refused their offers

According to Forbes magazine, Zuckerberg is worth approximately \$6.9 billion, surpassing even Apple founder Steve Jobs.

We use the past simple tense to talk about finished actions in the past.	<i>When did I/she/he/we/they create the network? She created the network in December 2008. I started the network last year.</i>
Time expressions	<i>I looked at that yesterday. I had broadband connected three days/a month/two years ago. I used that system last week/year/month. I started that user group on Monday/in June/in 2001.</i>


