Verbo to be e verbos modais

To be	Can	Must	May	Will
I am	I can	I must	I may	I will
you are	you can	you must	you may	you will
he/she/it is	he/she/it can	he/she/it must	he/she/it may	he/she/it will
we are	we can	we must	we may	we may
you are	you can	you must	you may	you may
they are	they can	they must	they may	they may

The children **are** in the swimming pool. They **can** swim well.

Interrogativa: **Are** the children in the swimming pool? **Can** they swim well?

Negativa: The children **aren't** in the swimminh pool. They **can't** swim well.

Outros Verbos – No Present simple os outros verbos levam um "s" na terceira pessoa do singular (he / she / it)

Precisam de auxiliar (to do) para formar a interrogativa e a negativa

To drive	To Do	
I drive	I do	We drive to work every day.
you drive	you do	Do we drive to work every day?
he/she/it/ drives	he/she/it does	We don't drive to work every day.
we drive	We do	Mary drives to school on Mondays.
you drive	You do	Does Mary drive to school on Mondays?
they drive	They do	Mary doesn't drive to school on Mondays.

FORMA:

Na interrogativa Do + Sujeito + Verbo principal no infinitivo (sem to)

Na negativa Sujeito + do + **NOT** + Verbo principal no infinitivo (sem to)
