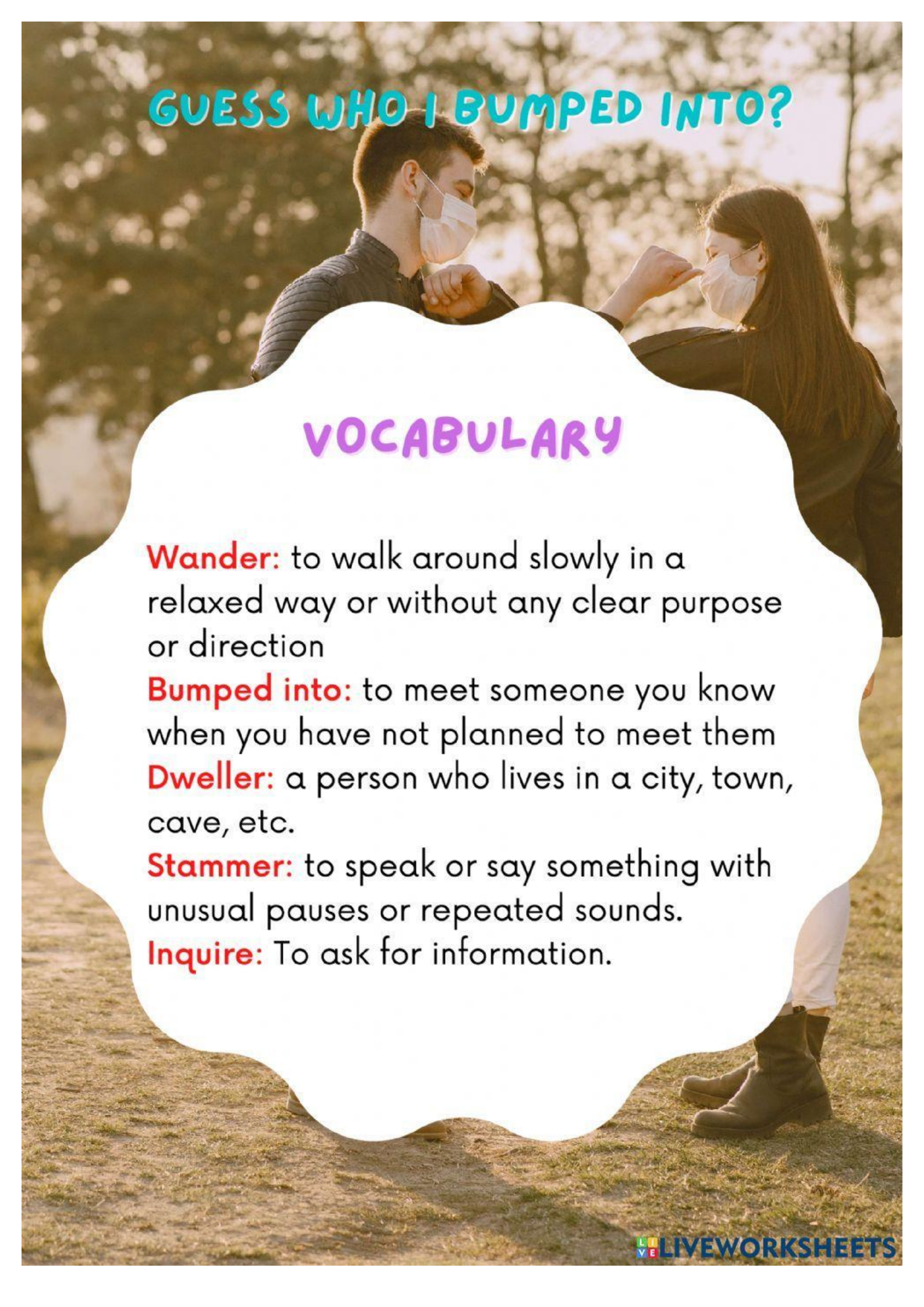

Wander: to walk around slowly in a relaxed way or without any clear purpose or direction

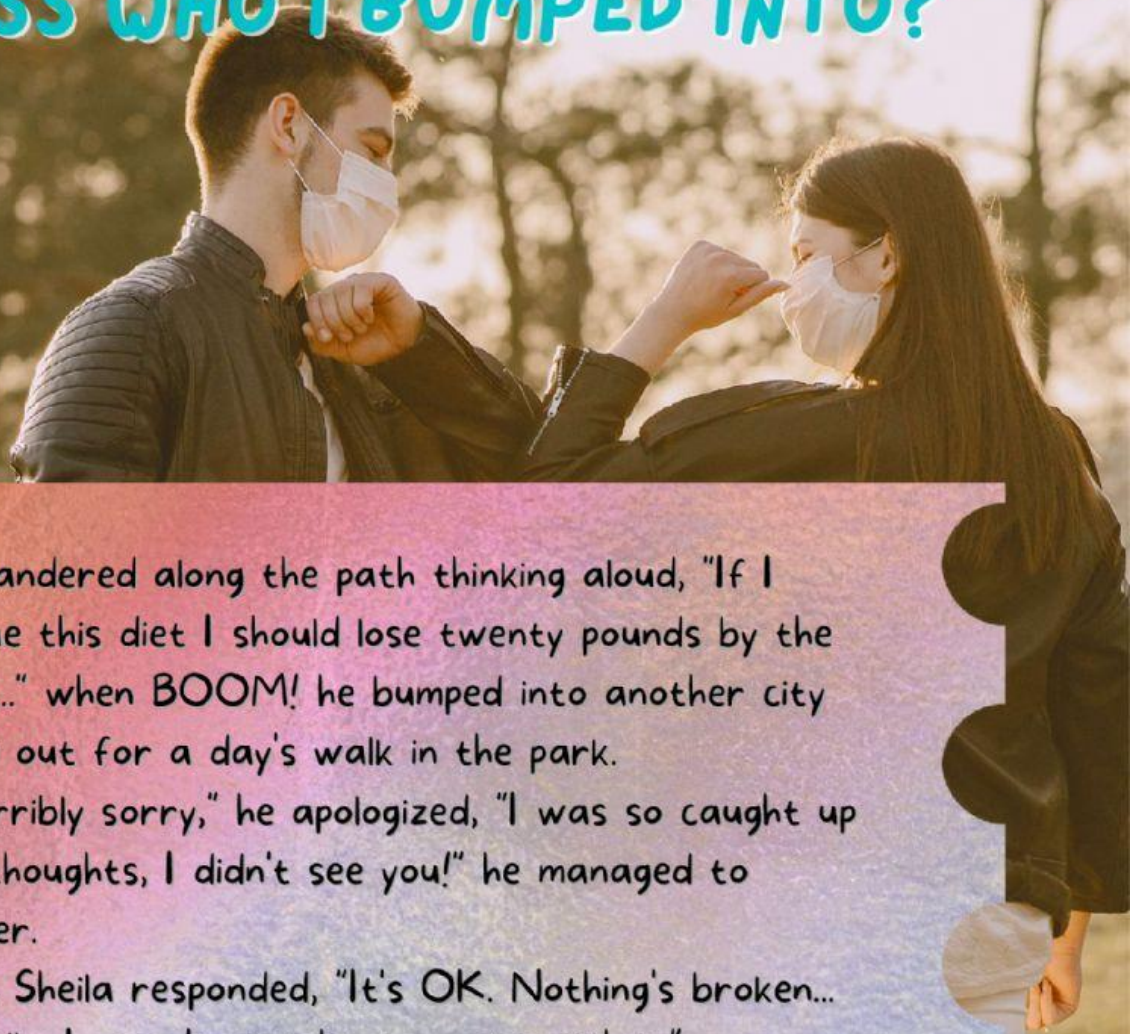
Bumped into: to meet someone you know when you have not planned to meet them
