There was new interest in Ireland's past – its sport, language and mythology. **Creation of the GAA.**

Some people wanted Northern Ireland to be united with the Republic of Ireland. Others wanted to remain in the UK. Bombings, killings and street fights happened frequently.

After a civil war, Ireland split into two countries :  
- the Irish Free State (independent)  
- Northern Ireland (part of the UK)

There was a march for the Civil Rights. The British army shot civilians and killed fourteen people.

The GAA commemorated the event at Croke Park stadium in Dublin.

The troubles officially ended.

Irish nationalists rebelled against the British government. The British authorities stopped the rebellion but the fight for independence continued.

The movement fought to end discrimination against the Catholic minority in Northern Ireland.
