**\*\* A tag question is a short question added to the end of a positive or negative statement.**

For example:

He is a doctor, isn't he?

He will buy a car, won't he?

He can speak English, can't he?

**\*\* A positive sentence is followed by a negative tag, and a negative sentence is followed by a positive tag.**

e.g: He is a doctor , isn't he ?

↓                      ↓  
positive sentence    negative tag

He is not a doctor , is he ?

↓                      ↓  
Negative sentence    positive tag

**\*\* If the verb in the statements is an auxiliary one, then we use it in the tag. But if the statement doesn't have an auxiliary verb, then we use (don't, doesn't) in the tag part.**

Safa **prays** every day, **doesn't** she?

Safa **doesn't** study, **does** she?

They **pray** every day, **don't** they?

They **don't** study, **do** they?
