Newcastle Upon Tyne is a city in North East England. Its population is less than 300,000, but it is known as one of the most fun cities in Britain!

Newcastle's most famous sight is its Tyne Bridge. It was built in the 1920s and goes over the river Tyne.

The weather in Newcastle is often very cold, but it doesn't stop the local people from going out and having fun. It also doesn't stop its football team, Newcastle United, from playing well. The football club's home is in the city's sports stadium, called St James' Park, and welcomes about 50,000 people to watch its football matches every week.

The city also attracts a lot of visitors. They come to see the Tyne Bridge, to go to the city's excellent shops, and to visit the famous art galleries. In the Laing you can find paintings and sculptures from the 18th, 19th and 20th centuries and across the bridge, the Baltic Flour Mill is home to modern art.

It's easy to reach Newcastle. You can travel there by bus or take a train. It's also easy to travel in and around Newcastle. There are lots of buses, and the city also has an excellent underground system. Trains run all around the city, and out to the beaches nearby at Whitley Bay and Tynemouth.

Newcastle is also famous for its friendly people, who are always ready to welcome visitors. Newcastle upon Tyne might be a small city, but it's got a big heart!
