

## Question tags & Present Simple

Question tags can be positive (+) and negative (-). All of them use short forms of

auxiliary verbs and subject pronouns.

Look at the examples below:

- Richard *plays* tennis, *doesn't he?*
- Our friends *don't like* marrows, *do they?*
- Mr. Black *is* an engineer, *isn't he?*
- Rob and Ted *aren't* students, *are they?*
- I *am* your roommate, *aren't I?* (exception)
