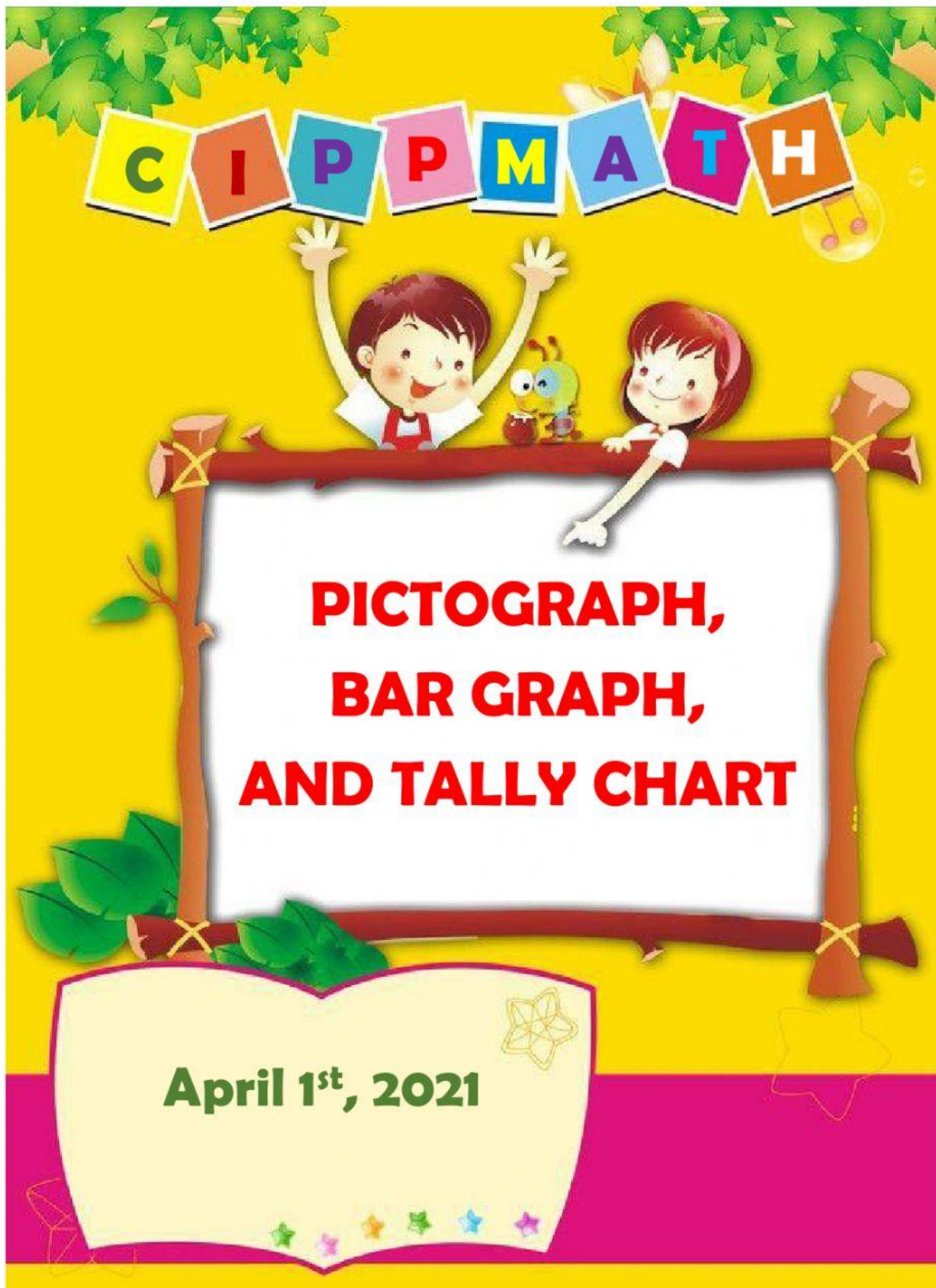

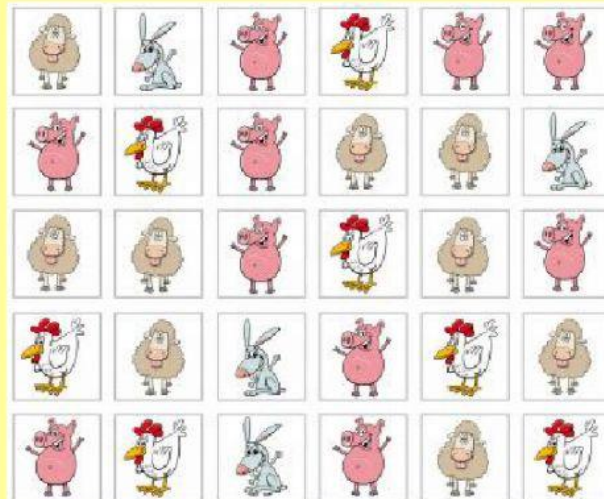

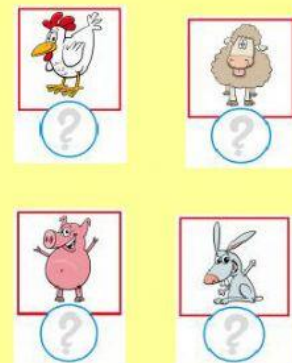
Hello my Lower B friends!

They are pictograph, bar graph and tally chart. Although they have different form, but have same function. They are easy and quick to read. Let's take a look at this picture.



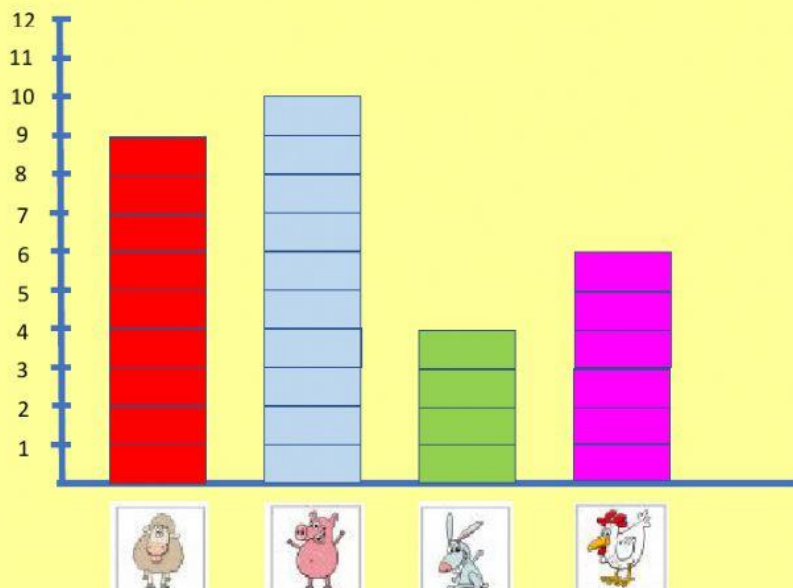
HOW MANY?

10 pigs

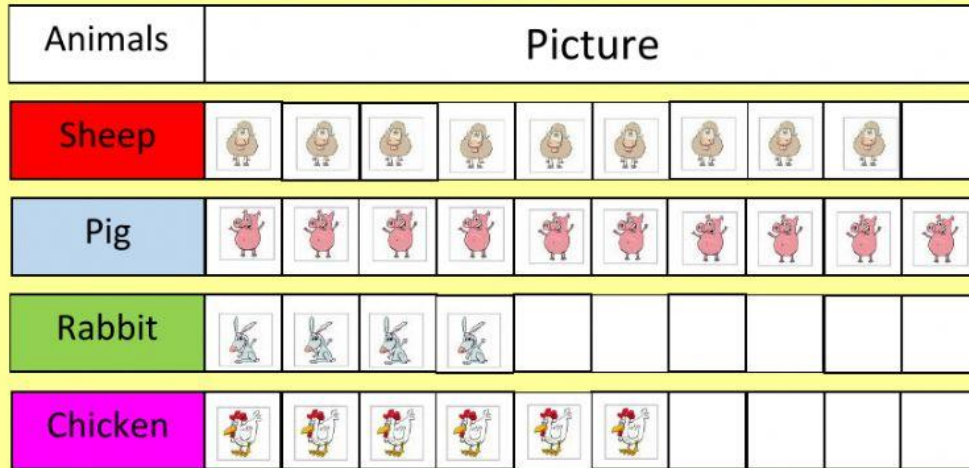

4 rabbits



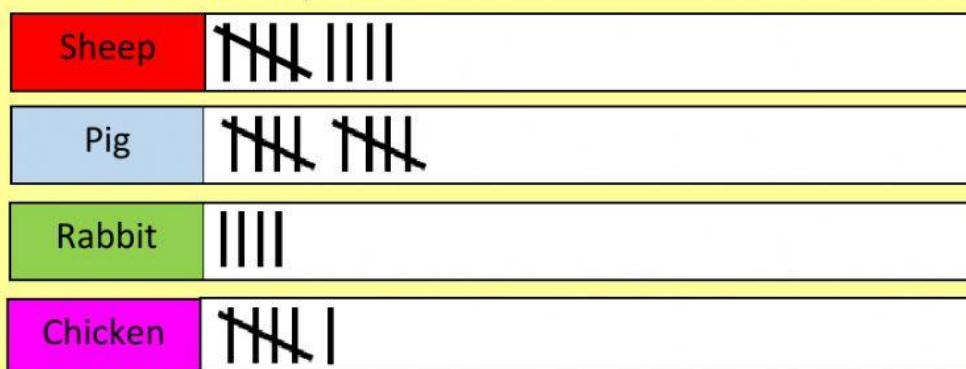

10 pigs

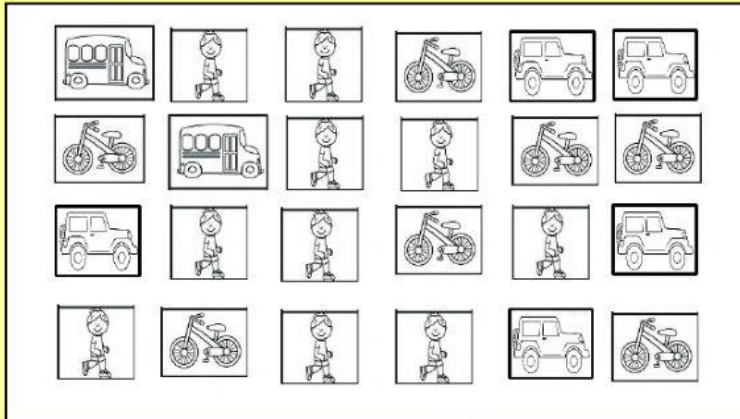

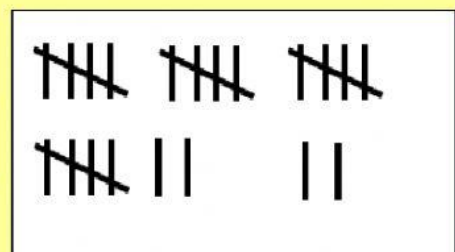

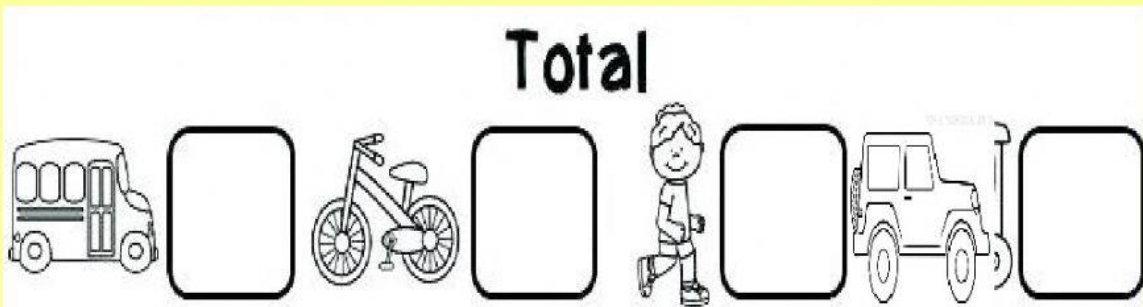
