
Indefinite pronouns

Pronouns ending in -one or -body are used to refer to people.

Example

Everyone is ready to go.

Pronouns ending in -thing are used to refer to things.

Example

Everything had gone silent.

Pronouns ending in -where are used to refer to places that you do not know.
