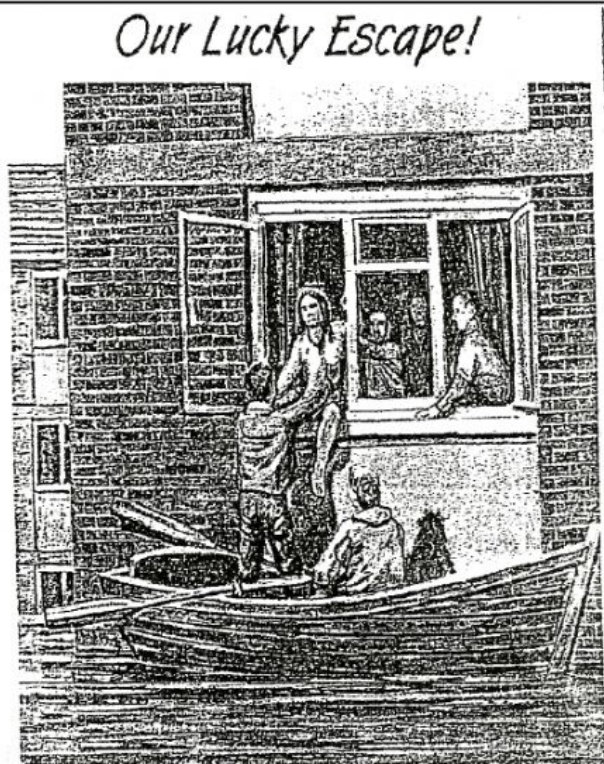
**Reading comprehension**
