Recycling plastic using a recycling plant is easy. However, plastic have different formulations and should be sorted before they are recycled tp make new products. Mixed plastic can be recycled, but they are not as valuable as sorted plastics because the recycled plastic's physical properties, such as strength, may vary with each batch.

A recycling plant uses several steps to turn plastic trash into recycled plastic. First, the plastic trash is inspected for contaminants like rock and glass, and plastics that the plant cannot recycle. This process is called inspection. Next, in chopping and washing process, the plastic is washed and chopped into flakes. In a flotation tank, mixed plastics which are being recycled, are sorted, where some types of plastic sink and others float. The fourth process is drying.

Here, the plastic flakes are dried in a tumble dryer. Then, we come to the melting step. The dried flakes are fed into an extruder, where heat and pressure melt the plastic. Different types of plastics melt at different temperatures. The molten plastic is forced through a fine screen to remove any contaminants that slipped through the washing process. It is then formed into strands. This whole process is known as filtering.

Finally, before the strands are chopped into uniform pellets, they are cooled in water first. Manufacturing companies buy these plastic pellets from recyclers to make new products. Recycled plastics also can be made into flower pots, lumber, and carpeting.
