Exercise 2. " Jim Crow" Laws

- 💡 The name « Jim Crow » is often used to describe the segregation laws. Jim Crow was a black character (a caricature of a silly and clumsy black slave) performed by a white actor called Thomas Rice. Those laws, that established « separate but equal » standard, were enforced by various American States from 1896 to 1964.



Look at the map and read the laws. Rephrase the laws using "HAD TO" and "BE



• **Intermarriage:** "No person having one-eighth part or more of negro blood shall be permitted to marry any white person." *Missouri* 1879

• **Education:** White and colored persons shall not be taught in the same school. *West Virginia* 1872

• **Health:** An Alabama law prohibits white female nurses from caring for black male patients. *Alabama* 1915
