<b>0 conditional</b> used for present, real/factual situations	present simple If I <u>study</u> hard,	present simple I <u>always pass</u> my exams.
<b>1st conditional</b> used for future real/factual situations	present simple If I <u>study</u> hard,	will + base verb I <u>will pass</u> my exams.
<b>2nd conditional</b> used for present or future unreal, imaginary situations	past simple If I <u>studied</u> hard,	would + base verb I <u>would pass</u> my exams.
