new popular music style **popular** among **young people**. They have a good **rhythm**, a **catchy melody**, and are easy to remember and sing.

A genre of **African-American music** of the 1980s and 1990s in which **rhyming lyrics** are “**spoken**” accompanied by music. It is **influenced by rap and funk**.

popular music of **Jamaican origin** that **combines native styles** with elements of rock and soul music. A famous singer of this style was **Bob Marley**.

a form of popular music that **evolved** in the 1950s from rhythm and blues, **characterized by the use of electric guitars**.

music which is **made with electronic equipment** such as synthesizers or **computers**.

popular music of **Puerto Rican origin** that **combines** rap with Caribbean rhythms.

a sub-genre of **hip hop music** that **originated** in the **Southern United States** during the late 1990s. The genre **gets its name** from an **Atlanta slang** word which **refers to** a place in which drugs are sold illegally.
