

## Reading comprehension: "STREET FOOD"

Do you think fast food is an *American Phenomenon*? Well, *it isn't!* Let's find out more. In the past, fast food was street food because people weren't always at home for meals. *In ancient Rome* people ate bread and olives on the streets. In the Middle East people bought bread and sauces in the street.

In Victorian Britain, people bought roast chestnuts in the winter.

*Today* people still buy traditional food to eat on the streets. In France people eat "crêpes", in Belgium people eat "waffles" and in Italy people eat "pizza". What about the English Speaking World?

In Trinidad and Tobago, people buy bread called "roti". They eat it with meat and curry. In Jamaica people eat "patties". In *India* people drink spicy tea and eat deep-fried sweets. In Australia people buy steak sandwiches and ice-creams from mobile vans. People in *Britain* often eat fish and chips outside. They also eat "kebabs" in the streets. In Canada people also eat chips. They buy them from chips wagons and eat them with a meat sauce.

So, what about America? The most common *street food in America is the hot dog*. Can you remember people buying hot dogs in the streets in any scenes from films? *The big cities in America* also have a lot of *ethnic street food*. People can buy Chinese, Caribbean, Mexican, Vietnamese, Thai and Indian food on the streets as well as pizza, ice-creams and many other things!

It's important to be careful. Today's fast food sometimes has a lot of fat, sugar and salt. When you buy street food or fast food, always check the *ingredients*. *If there is a lot of sugar or salt*, don't buy the food. Remember fast isn't always good, but it isn't always terrible either and it has a very long history.
