1. _____ large inland bodies of water. Almost all lakes hold fresh water and are fed and drained by small rivers or streams.
 2. _____ deep underground holes (pockets) between the soil and rocks
 3. _____ mammoth bodies of saltwater. There are five of these and they cover 70% of the Earth's surface and contain 97% of the planet's water.
 4. _____ this is a large human-made "lake" that captures water from nearby creeks and rivers and stores it.
 5. _____ large bodies of water that are surrounded by land on three sides. Usually have a small channel that connects them to a larger body of water, such as the ocean.
 6. _____ long, ribbon-like waterways that usually flow toward an ocean, lake, bay, or other rivers. These are fed by precipitation, snowmelt, or natural springs (water from beneath the Earth's surface).
