



GRAMMAR WORKSHEET

POSSESSIVE: -'S and -S'

singular nouns: add -'s <i>example: boy → boy's</i>	 The boy's <u>bicycle</u> is blue.  <i>It belongs to the boy.</i>
plural nouns: add -s' <i>example: boys → boys'</i>	 The boys' <u>bicycles</u> are blue.  <i>They belong to the boys.</i>
some irregular plural nouns: add -'s <i>example: children → children's</i>	 The children's <u>bicycles</u> are blue.  <i>They belong to the children.</i>

Example:

The children have a ball. The ball is lost. => The children's ball is lost.
