- We use **will / won't + infinitive** for making instant decisions, offers, and promises. We don't use the present tense.

I'll help you with those bags.

NOT ~~I help you with those bags.~~

- When an offer is a question, we use **Shall I...?** or **Shall we...?**

Shall I pay? Shall we do the washing-up?
