LUKE: Have you still got relatives in Poland?

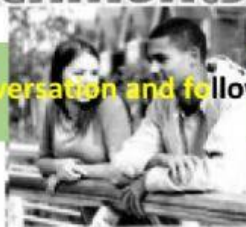
