



Present continuous tense

Remember the structures and remember that the verb "to be" in present → *am – is – are*

Affirmative → *subject + present verb "to be" + verb -ing + the rest of the sentence*

Example → *I am going shopping now / She is doing her homework at the moment.*

Negative → *subject + present verb to be + not + verb -ing + rest of the sentence*

Example → *We are not speaking to him right now. / He is not eating with us today.*

Contractions → are not = aren't / is not → isn't

Interrogative → *present verb "to be" + subject + verb -ing + rest of the sentence + ?*

Example → Are you playing fortnite later? / Is he coming to the party?

Interrogative with wh? → *Wh + present verb "to be" + subject + verb -ing + rest of the sentence + ?*

Example → Where is he teaching English right now? / Why are you crying?

Wh ? words → *what, where, why, when, who, which, how, how many, how much, how often*
