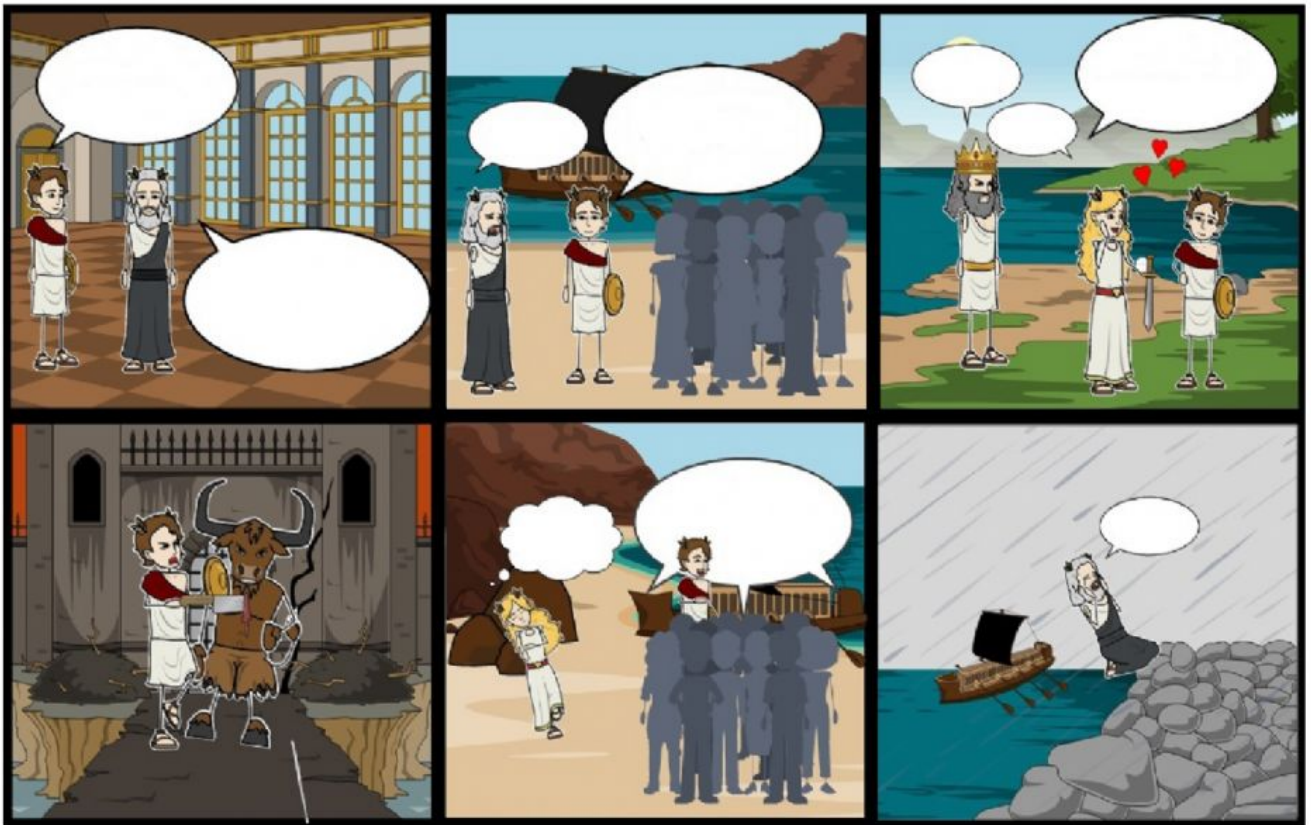
1. This can go on no longer. I'll put a stop to that. I'll kill the Minotaur and I'll change these black sails to white as a proof that I'll come out victorious.
