	<h3>How it all started</h3> <p>Steven Spielberg was born in Cincinnati, Ohio, on December 18, 1946. His mother was a restaurateur and concert pianist, his father was a computer engineer, and he had three sisters. He showed keen interest in photography and cinema from a very early age and, by the time he was 13, he had already shot a 40-minute film and had actually won a prize for it! In 1963, at age 16, Steven wrote and directed his first independent movie, a 140-minute science fiction adventure called <i>Firelight</i>.</p> <p>While he was a student at California State University, Long Beach, Spielberg made a short film which attracted the attention of Universal Studios. Though he was only 22, the studio signed him to a long-term deal as a director. Six years later, he reached world fame with <i>Jaws</i> which was an enormous hit and made him the youngest multi-millionaire in America.
