An irregular verb does not follow the pattern of regular verbs in terms of adding an-ed for the past.

Affirmative +		
I	drank	hot chocolate.
You	caught	a fish.
Не	made	a fire.
She	ate	marshmallows.
We	found	wood.
They	slept	in a tent.

Negative			
I	didn't drink	hot chocolate.	
You	didn't catch	a fish.	
He	didn't make	a fire.	
She	didn't eat	marshmallows.	
We	didn't find	wood.	
They	didn't sleep	in a tent.




