The **yoo** sound can be spelled **ew**, as in pewter. The **oo** sound can be spelled in several ways: **ew**, as in mildew; **ue**, as in pursued; **oo**, as in smoother; **ui**, as in juicy. The short **i** sound can also be spelled with **ui**, as in circuit.
