## Regular verbs

Spelling rules	Examples
<b>base form + ed</b>	<b>walk</b> → <b>walked</b> <b>play</b> → <b>played</b>
<b>verbs ending in -e + d</b>	<b>like</b> → <b>liked</b> <b>move</b> → <b>moved</b>
<b>verbs ending in a consonant + y</b> ↓ <b>change y → i + ed</b>	<b>carry</b> → <b>carried</b> <b>study</b> → <b>studied</b>
<b>Some verbs ending in a single consonant + the second last letter is a vowel → double the last letter + ed</b>	<b>plan</b> → <b>planned</b> <b>stop</b> → <b>stopped</b>
