

Theme: Respect



The word, “**respect**” means a high or special regard; a relation or reference to a particular thing or situation.

To have **respect** for authority is to **honour** or to **submit** to those in leadership positions. Such persons include your parents, principals, teachers, elders, law enforcement agents, prefects etc.

Many **biblical characters** demonstrated respect for authority. They include David and Paul.

- David respected King Saul as his leader even though King Saul wanted to kill him. Even when God rejected Saul as king, David still respected him.
- In the New Testament, Paul sent Onesimus, a runaway slave, back to his owner, Philemon. Paul respected the authority of Philemon.

Individuals should demonstrate respect for persons in authority.

- Children should demonstrate respect by obeying rules at home and in school.
- Adults should demonstrate respect by obeying laws in the work place and in the community.

All persons should use good manners to demonstrate respect.
