Would prefer/ Would Rather

WOULD PREFER

We use 'prefer-ing' to say what we prefer in general

- Would prefer + TO V1
 I would prefer to drink tea.
- Would prefer + Noun (TO Noun)
 I would prefer pizza to hamburger.
 I would prefer pizza.
- Prefer + Ving TO Ving.
 Layla prefers swimming to jogging in the park.

WOULD RATHER

We use 'would rather' to say what we want in a particular situation (not in general)

Would rather + Verb THAN Verb

Layla would rather swim than jog in the park.
