- On + days of the week (días de la semana) → on Mondays
- On + dates (fechas) → on (the) 5th (of) June
- On + particular days (días en particular) → on my birthday
- On + particular days (días en particular) → on the following day



in

- In + parts of the day (partes del día) → in the morning
- In + months (meses) → in December
- In + seasons (estaciones) → in winter
- In + years (años) → in 2015
- In + decades (décadas) → in the 1990's
- In + centuries (siglos) → in the 20th century
