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The Martian is a captivating science-fiction adventure novel written by Andy Weir. It tells the intriguing story of astronaut, Mark Watney, and his mission to the most inhospitable planet - Mars.

The story follows Mark, **1)** finds himself stranded alone on Mars' surface after a fierce dust storm nearly kills him and forces his crew to evacuate the planet.
