

COUNTABLE AND UNCOUNTABLE NOUNS & QUANTIFIERS

Os **quantificadores (quantifiers)** são expressões utilizadas para indicar a quantidade de objetos, pessoas ou animais em uma frase. Para muitos estudantes do idioma, pode parecer confuso sobre qual partícula deve ser utilizada em quais contextos. Logo, é preciso entender o significado de cada uma a fim de empregá-las de forma correta.

Os quantificadores mais utilizados na comunicação em língua inglesa são: **much, many, a lot, some, any, a few e a little**.













