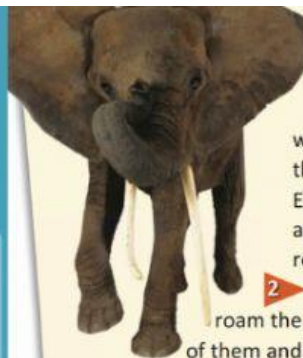


Become a volunteer for the **Sea Turtle Protection** **Society** in Greece!
