SIMPLE PAST (-) NEGATIVE

Look at these examples-

I **worked** yesterday.
I didn't work yesterday.



They **played** tennis last week.
They didn't play tennis last week.

When we say we didn't do something in the past we use-
didn't + a present simple verb. *I didn't work last week.*

We do not add 'ed' to the verbs- *They didn't work last week.*
