*Simple past questions: Did + subject + infinitive*

*I learned English last week. Did I learn English last week?*

*They wanted to sing yesterday. Did they want to sing yesterday?*

I phoned you yesterday. \_\_\_\_\_ you yesterday?

Susan slept well last night. \_\_\_\_\_ well last night?

They worked on Monday last week. \_\_\_\_\_ on Monday last week?

We played football this afternoon. \_\_\_\_\_ football this afternoon?

John finished his homework on time. \_\_\_\_\_ his homework on time?

**Simple Past questions with was or were:**

**She was at the doctor. Was she at the doctor?**

**They were at the station. Were they at the station?**

He was in Berlin. \_\_\_\_\_ he in Berlin?

We were in New York. \_\_\_\_\_ we in New York?

You were in Hamburg. \_\_\_\_\_ you in Hamburg?

They were in Birmingham. \_\_\_\_\_ they in Birmingham?

The book was interesting. \_\_\_\_\_ the book interesting?

#### Questions with 'did' or was/were

My friend was at home. \_\_\_\_\_ my friend at home?

Mr Jones called the police yesterday. \_\_\_\_\_ Mr Jones call the police yesterday?

The film was interesting. \_\_\_\_\_ interesting?

They played football in the park. \_\_\_\_\_ football in the park?

They asked many questions last time. \_\_\_\_\_ many questions?

She talked to David a week ago. \_\_\_\_\_ to David a week ago?

Peter was in the park this morning. \_\_\_\_\_ in the park this morning?

#### Negatives with didn't, wasn't or weren't

Dad watched TV in the living room. He \_\_\_\_\_ TV in the kitchen.

Susan played in the garden. She \_\_\_\_\_ in the park.

They were at the cinema. They \_\_\_\_\_ at the zoo.

She was happy. She \_\_\_\_\_ sad.

John and Jenny were born in January. They \_\_\_\_\_ born in February.

They walked home. They \_\_\_\_\_ to school.

Susan loved Peter. She \_\_\_\_\_ John.

You studied at school. You \_\_\_\_\_ at home.

Mum was angry. She \_\_\_\_\_ tired.
