The particles are closed together. They have a fixed shape.

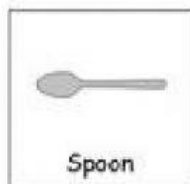
Liquids

This is an example of a liquid

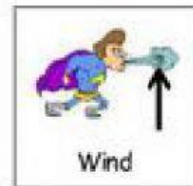
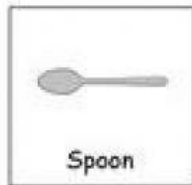
A cloud
