- Does coffee affect your mood?

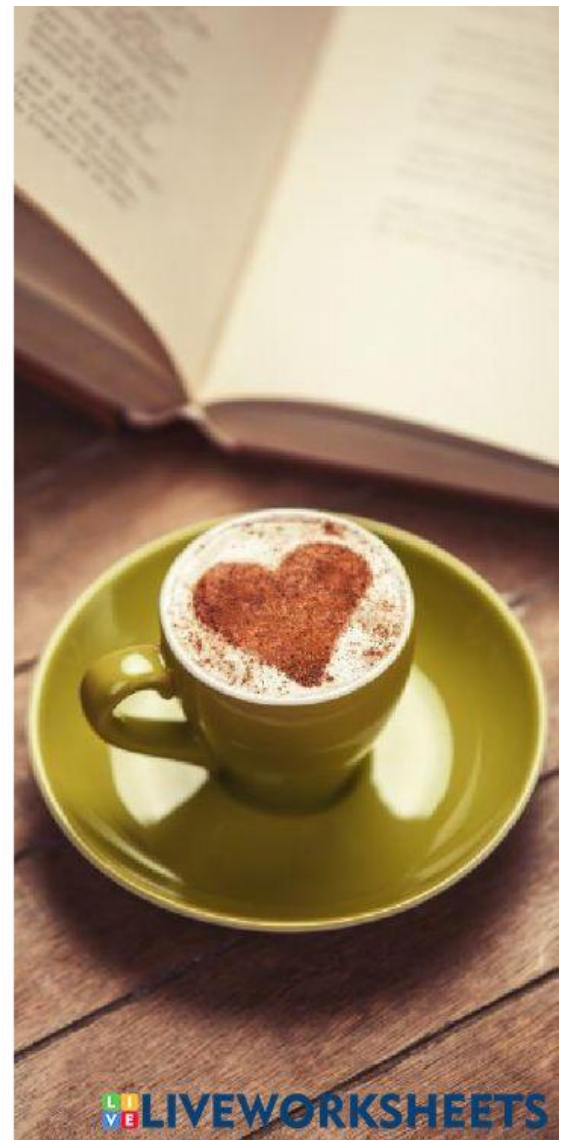


Speak your mind.

Think about:

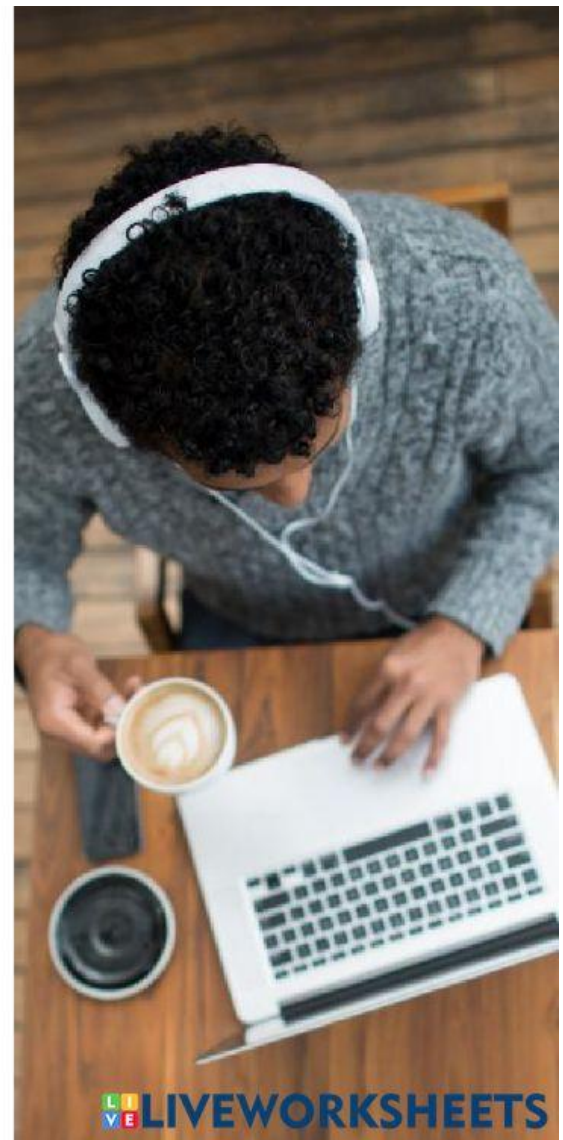
- What ingredients will you need?
