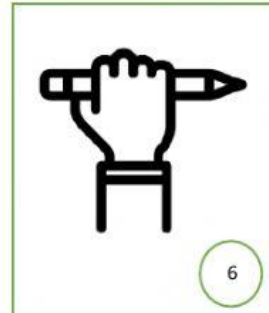
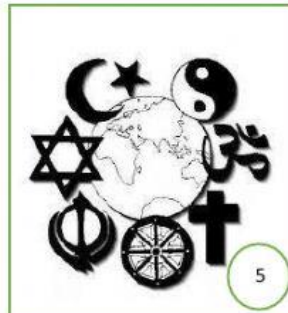
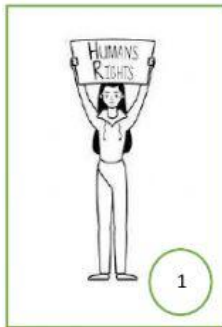

The right to **education** is recognized as a human right in international conventions which recognize a right to **free, compulsory primary education** for everybody and an obligation to **develop secondary education** accessible to all. Additionally, this right includes a responsibility to **provide basic education** for individuals who have not completed primary education. Also, it encompasses the obligation of the students to **avoid discrimination** at all levels of the educational system, to **set minimum standards of education** and to **improve the quality of education**.
