8. THIS IS WHERE YOU PAY FOR YOUR SHOPPING. IT'S USUALLY GOT A MACHINE THAT SCANS THE ITEMS YOU'RE BUYING AND A PLACE WHERE THE MONEY IS KEPT:
9. THIS IS THE PERSON WHO YOU PAY IN A SHOP. IN A SUPERMARKET THEY USUALLY PASS EVERY ITEM THROUGH A SCANNING MACHINE AND TELL YOU HOW MUCH MONEY YOU HAVE TO PAY FOR ALL YOUR ITEMS:
