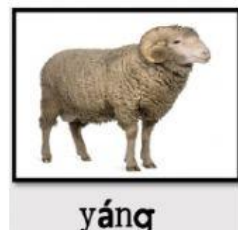
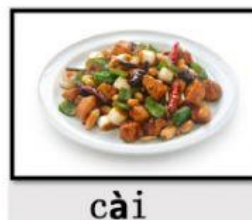

The position of tonal marks

1. The tonal mark is placed on the vowel, e.g.
bā jūn mǐn lēng
2. When there are two vowels, the tonal mark is placed on the earlier vowel in the sequence of: a o e i
u ü, e.g.
duō lái hòu xiě
3. When i u appear together, the tonal mark is placed on the last vowel, e.g.
zhui liú
