☞ There is / isn't a to express existence or non-existence in *singular*

☞ There are / aren't any to express existence or non-existence in *plural*

Example: There is a television in my living-room - (singular positive)

there isn't a clock on the wall - (singular negative)

.....
there are five dogs at home - (plural positive)

there aren't any students in the classroom - (plural negative)
