 - b) A Spanish Actor, director, producer and singer. He received numerous awards, including a Cannes Best Actor Award and European Film Award for Best Actor as well as five Golden Globe Awards. He began his acting career with a series of films by director Pedro Almodovar in the 1980's and then appeared in several Hollywood films, such as Philadelphia.
