Remedial work 2

When the verb is in the **Present Simple** – Put the verb in the **Past Simple**

Examples: 1 - "I **like** to dress up and look nice."

She said she **liked** to dress up and look smart.

2 - "She **doesn't go** to the cinema with her sister"

They said she **didn't go** to the cinema with her sister.
