Past Simple and Past Continuous

When two past actions happen at the same time, we use the **past simple** for the short action and the **past continuous** for the longer action. We often use these verb forms when one action interrupts another. We connect the actions with **when** (before the past simple) or **while** (before the past continuous).

When +	<input type="text"/>	(past simple) the fire alarm went off, I was <input type="text"/> (past continuous) dinner.
Past Simple	The researchers were hiking <input type="text"/>	(past simple) they saw the fossil.
While +	<input type="text"/> (past continuous) I wasn't looking, the thief <input type="text"/> (past simple) my bag.	
Past Continuous	Oliver found a fossil <input type="text"/> (past simple) he was <input type="text"/> (past continuous) outside.
