REGULAR VERBS



S + V-ed

She **worked** yesterday.



S + did not + verb

She **didn't work** yesterday.



Did + S + verb

Did she **work** yesterday?

IRREGULAR VERBS

S + V (forme spéciale)

She **went** to London last year.

S + did not + verb (infinitif)

She **didn't go** to Cardiff.

Did + S + verb (infinitif)?

Did she **go** to Trafalgar Square?
